How to Direct Your Company's Tax Dollars to Benefit Your Community: It's easy...

- Over 20 million is available on a first come first serve basis for contributions to education improvement organizations like REF.
- The tax credit is a 75% credit (against taxes owed). However, if a company provides a written two-year commitment of equal funding, the credit becomes 90%(existing charitable deductions still apply with this credit, increasing the value of the tax credit). Eligible companies may take up to \$ 300,000 in tax credits per year. You can get up to \$ 100% PA Tax Credit on your Business Tax Return ...and still use it as a deduction on your Federal Return!
- **NEW! Subchapter S Corps, Limited Partnerships and other pass-through organizations are eligible. July 8 deadline.**
- Simply apply to the Department of Commerce and Economic Development (DCED) for the EITC program. Application forms are available online at www.newpa.com and www.radnoreducationalfoundation.org.
