## REF Awards \$25,000 for grants in 2009-10



The Foundation is proud to support \$ 25,000 for 8 grant awards to teachers and RTSD for programs that enhance and advance classroom curriculum. Grants were given to support

technology initiatives, RHS Robotics Team, Bodyworks molds at all elementary schools, Timeliner software for RMS, and laptops and boe-bot kits for RHS AP Aerospace Engineering. REF will supplement funding for the ACTS(Aligning Curriculum to Technology Standards) program (\$12,000) that supports our teachers with technology hardware and professional development to improve existing lessons and curriculum.
